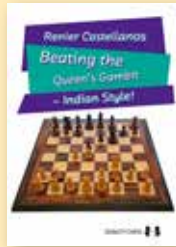


The Center Game: A Perfectly Playable Chess Opening Surprise

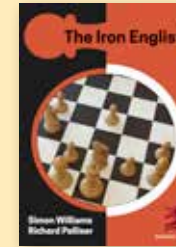


Reimagining 1.e4 - Clear, Cunning & Concise

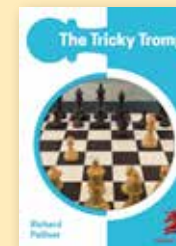


The Greatest
